Change in Grading Policy (as of 2018-19 school year)

AISC has moved to standards based assessment and reporting as of the 2018-19 school year. Students will receive feedback using a 1- 8 achievement scale and the recent, most consistent evidence of their learning in the areas of knowledge & understanding, thinking & transfer and communication. Due to the diverse international character of our students, AISC does not rank its students nor calculate a grade point average. For students in the Class of 2019, this change will only impact mid-year and final reports; a supplemental profile will be sent with those reports.

In recent years, and particularly this year, our students have had less access to SAT/SAT Subject and ACT tests because of fewer test dates abroad, fewer sites offering the test, score cancellations, technology difficulties, and higher fees. We ask that all higher education institutions take this into account when evaluating our students' applications.

DISCOVERY PROGRAM

All AISC high school students participate in the Discovery Program, which includes focused self reflection through the lens of AISC's Vision for a Learner and participation in a week-long trip within India.
